

SLES: Building Reopening Plans

1. Remote Instruction Choice

- Will be facilitated by a Springfield teacher, therefore student will still be enrolled at Springfield Elementary
- Lessons will be given via Zoom instruction, Google Classroom and/or written activities
- Students will meet with instructor daily during specific times to receive mini-lesson, then be required to complete assigned coursework
- Students will each be given a Google login account
- All remote learners will receive both online support with an instructor as well as assigned independent activities, which includes both written and online interactives
- Activities will be in line with what is being completed in the classroom
 - Kindergarten & Grade 1 students will receive 30 minutes per day of online support with an instructor
 - Grade 2 students will receive 60 minutes per day of online support with an instructor
 - Grades 3 and 4 students will receive 90 minutes per day of online support with an instructor

B. Student Expectations

- Will be required to take online assessments
- Any written assignments will need to be submitted at the end of each week
- Students will be encouraged to make a 9 week commitment to the remote or in person learning choice
- Students will receive grades as if they were in class
- Any students with IEP accommodations, will continue to receive services

August 4, 2020

- Grades will be as is unless SLES moves to a full remote learning option

2. Dismissal Procedures (mask required for parents & students)

A. Parent Pick-Up

- Dismissal will begin at 3pm for Parent pick up
- Parents must enter building to sign students out
- Parents will be required to use cafeteria and/or gymnasium in order to socially distance
- Please do not loiter, as soon as your student arrives, exit the building

B. Bus Dismissal

- Students will be dismissed one bus at a time
- Kindergarten students will be walked out by a teacher for the first 2 weeks
- Students will follow bus protocol when getting on the busses

3. Classroom Environment

- A. Face Coverings are required at all times inside the building
- B. Desks will be socially distanced in each classroom
- C. Students will be permitted to bring a water bottle in since water fountains will not be in use
- D. No outside toys/devices will be allowed in the building
- E. Students may bring backpacks & lunch boxes
- F. No outside birthday treats this year

4. Open House

A. A pre-recorded video will be uploaded to each teacher's website by September 4, 2020, explaining grade level expectations and classroom procedures. Families can view the presentations at their leisure and contact the teacher, Mrs. Davis or Mr. Albanese with any questions.
