

## Springfield Local Intermediate School Reopening Plans

### 1. Arrival

- a. **Temperature Scan-** Any person entering the building will pass by a thermal temperature scanner. If the person has a temperature they will not be permitted in the building. If the person is a student they will be escorted to a quarantine room in the office to be rechecked by the nurse. The nurse will determine if the student is sent home or remains in school.
  - b. **Entrance points-** Grades 5 and 6 will enter through the M21 entrance on the right side of the building near the bridge. Grades 7 and 8 students will enter through the main entrance in the front of the building. All students will have their temperature taken before entering the building. Students should not congregate in groups while waiting to get in the building. Social distancing reference marks will be on the sidewalk to help students maintain a safe social distance from each other.
  - c. **Breakfast-** Student who choose to eat breakfast will be permitted to enter the building at 7:10am. They will enter through the main entrance at the Intermediate school regardless of grade level. They report to the cafeteria to get their breakfast. Students will then take their breakfast to eat in the Intermediate School gymnasium. Students will sit in the bleachers to eat breakfast. Social distancing reference marks will be placed on the bleachers to help students maintain a safe social distance from each other.
  - d. **Lockers-** Students will not use their lockers to start the school year. They will be permitted to carry their book bags with them at all times throughout the school day. Students should keep all supplies and materials in their book bags.
  - e. **Homerooms-** Students will report to their assigned homeroom for the purpose of attendance and morning announcements.
2. **Class Changes-** There will be a staggered dismissal in-between all hall transition times. On the second floor 6<sup>th</sup> grade students will be dismissed first while 5<sup>th</sup> grade students remain in their classrooms. Once the 6<sup>th</sup> grade clears the hall 5<sup>th</sup> grade teachers will release their students. On the first floor 8<sup>th</sup> grade students will be dismissed first while 7<sup>th</sup> grade students remain in their classrooms. Once the 8<sup>th</sup> grade clears the hall 7<sup>th</sup> grade teachers will release their students.
  3. **Stairwells-** The stairwell at the East end of the building (6<sup>th</sup>& 8<sup>th</sup> grade halls) will be designated as an up only stairwell. The stairwell at the West end of the building (5<sup>th</sup>&7<sup>th</sup> grade halls) will be designated as a down only stairwell. Teachers will assist and monitor student traffic on stairwells.
  4. **Hallways-** Students should remain to the right side when walking in a hallway. Arrows and social distancing reference marks will be placed in all the hallways to help students maintain a safe social distance from each other.

5. **Classrooms-** teachers will space students apart at as best as possible. All classroom high touch surfaces will be sprayed with a disinfectant in between all class changes. Students will not be required to wear a mask during physical education when exerting high levels of physical activity.
6. **Lunch-**
  - a. **7<sup>th</sup>&8<sup>th</sup> grade lunch-** 8<sup>th</sup> grade will be dismissed first. Packers will report to the intermediate school gymnasium. Buyers will report to the cafeteria and immediately get in line. Once a student receives their lunch they will report to the gymnasium. Students will then eat their lunch in the Intermediate School gymnasium. 8<sup>th</sup> grade students will sit in the bleachers to eat lunch. Social distancing reference marks will be placed on the bleachers to help students maintain a safe social distance from each other. 7<sup>th</sup> grade will report to the cafeteria and follow normal cafeteria procedures.
  - b. **5<sup>th</sup>&6<sup>th</sup> grade lunch-** 6<sup>th</sup> grade will be dismissed first. Packers will report to the intermediate school gymnasium. Buyers will report to the cafeteria and immediately get in line. Once a student receives their lunch they will report to the gymnasium. Students will then eat their lunch in the Intermediate School gymnasium. 6<sup>th</sup> grade students will sit in the bleachers to eat lunch. Social distancing reference marks will be placed on the bleachers to help students maintain a safe social distance from each other. 5<sup>th</sup> grade will report to the cafeteria and follow normal cafeteria procedures.
  - c. **Water fountains-** All water fountains will be turned off. Students will be permitted to have a personal water bottle. Bottle filling stations will be turned on for student use.
7. **Dismissal-** There will be a staggered dismissal to avoid hallway crowding. 8<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade students will be dismissed first. Once the hallways clear the 7<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade students will be dismissed.
8. **Grades-** Springfield Intermediate School will follow the normal BOE adopted grading scale located in the student handbook.
9. **Face coverings-** All students will be required to wear a face coverings as outlined in the district plan. If a student is not compliant, they will be redirected by a teacher/staff member. If unsuccessful the student will be sent to Mr. Malone. If the student is not compliant with mandatory face coverings, they will be asked to attend school virtually.
